

## What happens after you submit your forms

1. You will receive a call within seven days of receipt of the patient information from a member of our nursing staff to:
  - Help you pick a day and time for your colonoscopy
  - Give an overview of the procedure and the procedure day
  - Review anesthesia questions with you
  - Answer any questions you have
2. On our website, [www.FallHillGastro.com](http://www.FallHillGastro.com) you will be able to find forms reviewing the preparation instructions, diet instructions, and directions to the Endoscopy Center.
  - Your prescription for the laxative preparation will be faxed to your pharmacy.
  - Consent forms for the Colonoscopy and Anesthesia will be given to you at the Endoscopy Center on the day of your procedure for you to review and sign.
3. Two days before your colonoscopy, the endoscopy nurse will call you again to confirm the appointment date and time, answer questions and review instructions.
4. You need to arrive at the endoscopy center one hour prior to your scheduled procedure time.
5. On the day of the procedure please bring your picture identification and your current insurance card, and your co-pay if not already submitted.
6. You may receive a bill from Fall Hill Gastroenterology, Somnia Anesthesia group, and Theranostix Pathology Services.
7. As you leave you will receive a full report of your procedure. The results of any biopsies will be sent to you by letter when available.
